**ASTON, PA.** 5/1/2026 – MIPC, LLC today issued the following statement in response to discovering air quality concerns inside nearby residences.

MIPC has been working to remediate a gasoline tank release at its Aston, PA facility. As part of this work, MIPC has sought and been granted access to conduct investigative work, including vapor intrusion evaluations, on a few properties that abut MIPC's western fenceline.

Testing has identified air quality concerns inside of two nearby residences that abut our fence line. We are addressing this finding with urgency and care to ensure that these concerns are properly investigated and mitigated.

As part of this process, and out of an abundance of caution, we have temporarily relocated one neighbor who will need a mitigation system, until the system is installed and operating. This is similar to a home radon mitigation system. We will ensure that the installation, operation and maintenance of these systems are without costs to the property owners.

Additionally, we are providing temporary housing to the affected neighbor at no cost and we are committed to doing everything we can to expedite installation.

MIPC is undertaking this work in close coordination with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. We care deeply about this community, and we take our responsibilities to our neighbors seriously. We sincerely apologize for the concern that this creates for our community.
