On April 9, 2026, the Department of Environmental Protection (“DEP”) received MIPC, LLC’s “Request Regarding Discontinuation of Weekend Fenceline Air Monitoring – Passive Solar Skimmer Operation” related to the daily fenceline air monitoring required by Paragraph 1.e. of the December 23, 2025 Order (“Order”). On May 6 and May 20, 2026, MIPC, LLC provided additional information to DEP via e-mail regarding the weekend operations of the solar skimmers.

DEP reviewed and approves MIPC, LLC’s request to pause air monitoring during weekend days when only the solar skimmers are in operation and while following the procedures outlined in MIPC, LLC’s May 20, 2026 e-mail.

Please contact DEP if MIPC, LLC proposes to perform other operations at the site on weekends to determine if fenceline air monitoring would be required.
